

To Whom it May Concern:



About a year ago some friends of ours had their basement finished by Tory Maloney and my wife and I had the opportunity to see the entire process from start to finish. Neither our friends nor my wife and I are capable of completing the scope of work that Tory completed in that basement. He turned an underutilized cellar storage space into an integral part of the home in which children can play and adults can socialize. His work greatly improved the value of our friends' house in an amazingly short period of time and with an amazingly small amount of disruption.

My wife and I were impressed with the work and since we were considering having some improvements done in our house we got Tory's number and asked him to come over and provide us with an estimate for doing a major kitchen renovation. Tory patiently explained the entire process to us and told us right from the start about the things that would also need to be done in order to do the job properly. He gave us many choices as far as materials and was very reasonable about upgrades and changes to the original plan throughout the process. I have some other friends who are general contractors and they looked over the plan and the cost for me. They told me I was getting a really good deal and when the job was finished they were impressed with the quality of work I got for the price I paid. I should mention as well that our house is 80 years old and there are several different kinds of electrical wiring in the walls and some aspects of the plumbing are outdated as well. Tory handled all of these complications and took the time to explain to me throughout the process why he would have to do something in a particular way. We are extremely pleased with Tory's work and highly recommend him for any kind of home improvement project. In fact, we have had him back for several smaller projects already and intend to have him complete another large project in our house which will convert a large amount of storage space to living space for us.

Finally, I think I should mention something about Tory and his crew that I, as a father, consider extremely important. Tory and his men worked in our house for about six weeks on the kitchen. My wife is a stay-at-home mom and we have two young children at home and four children who go to school and are usually at home before Tory finished each day's work. We never heard either Tory or any of his men curse or use any language that we would have to explain to our children. The men were always well dressed, clean cut, and worked hard from the start of their day to the end. They were careful about our possessions and kind to our children and pets. Most people don't think about these things when they hire a contractor to do a job, I know I didn't, but my family and I really enjoyed having Tory and his guys here. In fact, the kids still rush out to say hi to him when he stops by to say hi when he's in the area. There are a lot of reasons to work with Tory: he does great work, he can fix difficult problems, and his prices are really reasonable, but for us the most important reason why we will have Tory back again is because he takes the time to get to know what we want, what we need, and what we can afford. He really cares about doing the entire job right.
